

2010 Meigs County Junior Fair King and Queen Competition

- The regulations for the King and Queen contest comply with the requirements for the State Contest.
 - The Meigs County Junior Fair King and Queen and Runner-up are selected from applications submitted from members of the various youth organizations including 4-H, FFA, FCCLA, Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, and Teen Institute on the basis of the following criteria:
 1. The King and Queen must be at least 16 years as of January 1st of the current year, not married nor have been married, nor have borne a child or be with child.
 2. No individual can serve as King or Queen or Acting King or Queen of the county or representative at the State Fair more than once. The Queen will be obligated to attend the State Fair unless illness or an emergency occurs and must immediately notify the Junior Fair Coordinator if unable to attend.
 3. The King and Queen and runners-up must have an exhibit in some form entered in the Junior Fair.
 4. The King and Queen will make themselves available for special presentations at the livestock shows and sales, and any other time as directed by the Junior Fair Board. Specific dress code attire will be expected at all times. (See code of conduct sheet.)
 5. Sash, Crown, and other official Royalty Attire issued by the Junior Fair Board must be worn at all times. (Unless washing or showing animals.)
 6. The King and Queen will be in all photos taken under the direction of the Junior and Senior Fair Boards. Runners-up will be in photos whenever the King or Queen is unavailable.
 7. The Junior and Senior Fair Boards expect courteous and orderly conduct by the applicants and their families. Harassment, profanity, or questionable conduct toward the fair officials, judges, coordinators, or other applicants will not be tolerated. Violators will be escorted from the fairgrounds.

1. Applications are available at the local high schools, Meigs County Extension Office, and online – www.themeigscountyfair.com.
2. Anyone wishing to compete for King and Queen must turn in a completed application form and essay and all must be TYPED.
3. Tentative interview for Royalty will be announced at a later time. Appropriate dress for an interview will be required.
4. All candidates will be required to participate in and furnish their own vehicle for the parade **on Sunday August 15th, 2010**. You must be there at 4:45pm for the parade lineup. Parade begins at 5:15pm. Crowning will follow the parade.
5. Applications must be received and/or postmarked by **Wednesday June 9th, 2010 at 5:00pm. No applications will be accepted after this date and time. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
